



## Snohomish County USBC All-Star Information & Application Adult & Youth – 2024 - 2025

The Snohomish County USBC *All-Star Committee* shall select the “All Stars” in accordance with the rules and guide lines provided. The chairperson shall make a report on the results of the meeting to the bowling centers and the SC USBC board. The Snohomish County USBC “All-Stars” Team members will be announced by the coaches within one week of the selection meeting. **April 27<sup>th</sup>** will be the deadline for notification.

The “All-Star” Teams shall consist of six (6) boys, six (6) girls selected from Snohomish County USBC bowlers. The coaches will determine line-ups and alternates during and throughout tournament play.

### ***Basic Requirements:***

Nominees must currently be a member in good standing (all dues current) with Snohomish County USBC and have participated in a certified (WIAA exempt) bowling league within a SCUSBC sanctioned house during the 2022-223 season. Applications will be accepted until the deadline of midnight, **May 4<sup>th</sup>**.

**Note:** Nominees must include a standing sheet from each certified league they participate in.

### ***Guide Lines for Selection Committee***

In addition to the minimum requirements stated above, the committee will take into consideration the following factors to assure only the most highly qualified candidates are nominated.

- 1) How many houses does the bowler bowl in?
- 2) How many games per league have they bowled?
- 3) Average: How does the nominee stack up, average wise with the other bowlers in the league? This must be a prime consideration to field a “competitive” All-Star team.
- 4) Tournament placement (individual and team), honor scores, awards (USBC and Local)
- 5) Sportsmanship: Consider such things as: loud, abusive language, hitting, kicking, and slapping the ball return, obscene body gestures, and intentional fouling.
- 6) Is the nominee a good candidate to represent the Snohomish County USBC bowling?

### ***General Information:***

To have coordinated dress, each bowler must wear ***black slacks***. Coordinated bowling shirts must be worn, when participating in ALL STAR matches. It is the bowlers’ responsibility to assure their individual shirt is clean and pressed for the ALL STAR matches. Shirts will be provided by Snohomish County USBC.

Lineage expenses will be paid for by the Snohomish County USBC. Matches will start on **June 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>**. The All-Star Tournament will be hosted by the **Greater Seattle USBC Association** the adult tournament and the youth tournaments will be held at Kenmore Lanes both Saturday and Sunday.

Any bowler displaying poor sportsmanship, such as hitting the ball return, obscene or abusive language, obscene gestures with the hands or body, intentional fouls, or not being in the bowling area when it is their turn to bowl will be pulled from the line-up for the balance of the matches.



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**FORMAT FOR THE ALL STAR TOURNAMENT**

**Saturday** Youth 4 games match play, 7 Baker matches

**Sunday** Youth 3 games match play, 7 Baker matches

Total points will determine the winner. Points will be earned as follows:

***MATCH PLAY*** Individual wins 1 point, Team wins 2 points

***BAKER MATCH*** Team wins 1 point per game, 3 points for total

There is no prize fund. All awards are in the form of plaques and trophies for the winning teams and high individual scores.
